## Executive Summary:

A placemaking vison and objectives are proposed for Esher Town Centre to guide and inform any new development on the Civic Centre site, any other development sites in the town centre or improvements which may come forward. Placemaking is a process centered on people and their needs, aspirations, and visions which relies strongly on community engagement. A public consultation with residents, businesses and stakeholders is proposed for March to seek their views on the draft vision and objectives.

## Report:

## 1. Background

- 1.1 Placemaking is a process centered on people and their needs, aspirations, and visions which relies strongly on community engagement.
- 1.2 A placemaking vision is an overarching idea that frames the reimagination and reinvention of places to improve and strengthen the connection between people and places. It is more that the redesign of buildings and streets it is about patterns of use, of sociability, uses, activity, access, and connections. Broader than a development brief or action plan, it can look holistically at a wider area to guide and effect change.

## 2. Esher Town Centre Placemaking Vision

2.1 The exploratory work being undertaken on options for redeveloping the Civic Centre has shown that due to the size and location of the site it is capable of significantly changing Esher town centre as a place. Of being a catalyst for placemaking across the town centre.

- 2.2 This creates an opportunity to draw on our 2030 Vision for Elmbridge, to take the principles of sustainable, thriving and community, and create a placemaking vision for Esher, created in consultation with the community. As well as guiding the redevelopment of sites such as the Civic Centre. Creating a single vision and direction for Esher will make it easier to pursue wider improvements projects with our stakeholders and partners.
- 2.4 Working with the Esher Ward Members a draft placemaking vision has been completed and is included in Appendix A for consideration.

- 4.1 The next stage in the preparation of the vision is to engage with residents, business and stakeholders. As part of this engagement a public consultation is proposed. The consultation will run for the whole month of March and will include: -
