

Elmbridge Borough Council Strategic CIL allocations 2015-17

Elmbridge Borough Council Cabinet has agreed that strategic CIL funding should be used towards the following programme of infrastructure improvements.

- Surrey County Council - Additional primary school places in the Walton and Hersham area - £662,974
- Surrey County Council – Works to support the growth of Cleves Junior Academy, Weybridge - £689,000
- Surrey County Council - Expansion and rebuild of Hurst Park Primary School, Molesey - £326,676
- Surrey County Council - Expansion and rebuild of Cranmere Primary School, Esher - £380,000
- Surrey County Council - Expansion of Manby Lodge Infant School - £78,145
- Surrey County Council - Expansion of Ashley Primary School, Walton on Thames - £300,000
- Surrey County Council - Multi Use Games Area, Burhill Primary School, Hersham - £175,000
- Surrey County Council - Expansion of Hinchley Wood Primary School - £55,600
- Surrey County Council - Works to enable provision of a bulge class at Cobham Free School - £30,000
- Surrey County Council - Multi Use Games Area, St Lawrence C of E Junior School - £100,000
- Surrey County Council - Bus stop accessibility improvements and Real Time Passenger Information - £110,000
- Surrey County Council - Highways safety scheme around Hinchley Wood Schools - £260,000
- Environment Agency - Telemetry equipment on the River Rytte - £6,000
- Elmbridge Borough Council - New Elmbridge Sports Hub, Waterside Drive. Work includes synthetic turf pitch, additional athletic tracks and children's play area - £2,156,000

- Elmbridge Borough Council - New outdoor gym equipment - £95,000
