

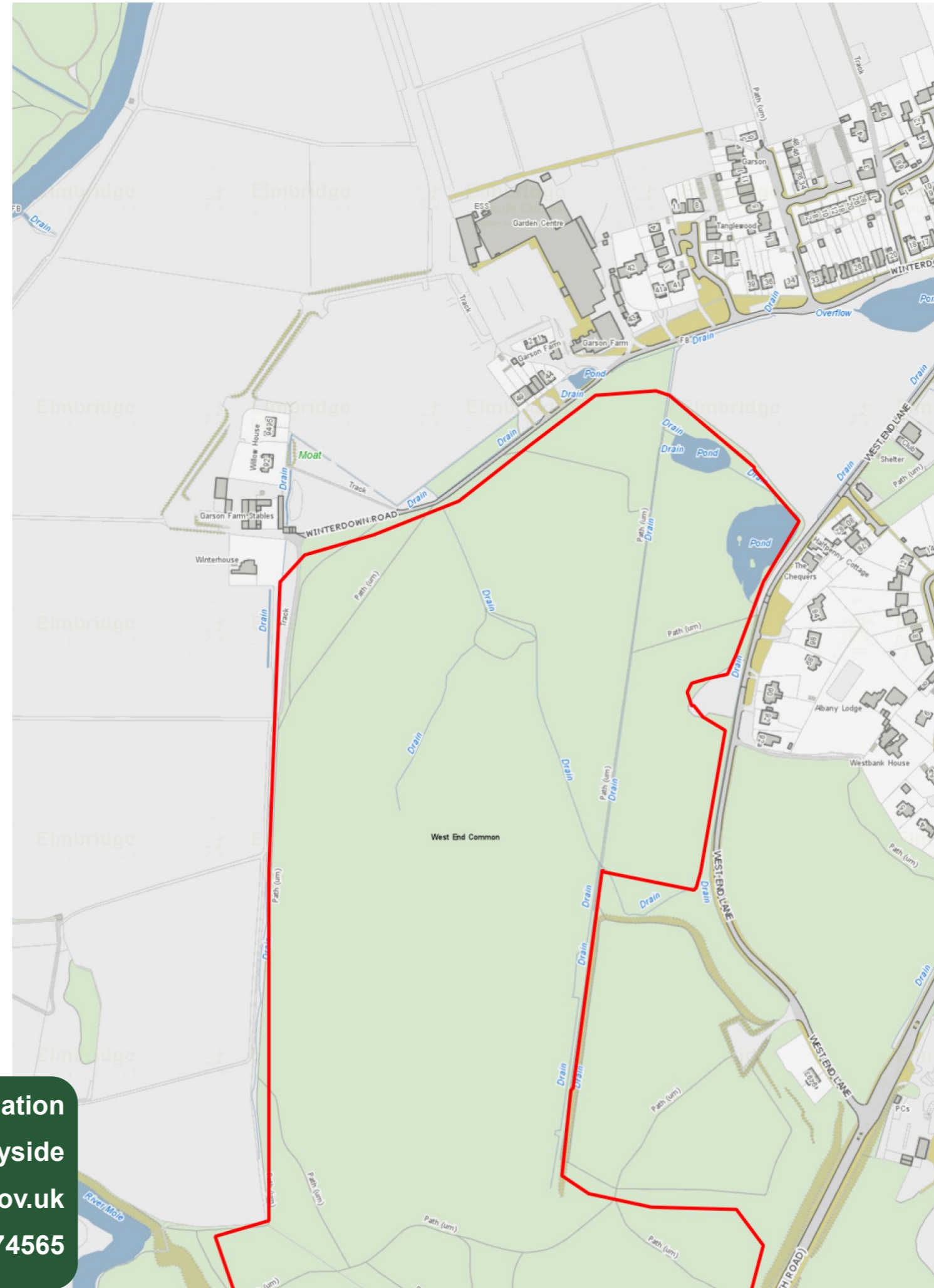
Woodland Management Autumn 2018 West End Common

This Autumn forestry contractors will be working on West End Common in the area outlined in red on the plan. This is the first year of a five year programme of thinning works across West End Common which will involve :

- Thinning 30% of the canopy to improve light penetration
- Non-native/invasive species control such as Turkey Oak, Laurel and Rhododendron
- Creation and maintenance of rides and glades

The thinning of the woodland allows light in to benefit wildlife and amenity across West End Common. The work is part of the on-going Woodland Management programme across Elmbridge's Countryside Estate approved by the Forestry Commission and the Countryside Consultative Group.

The works will be carried out during September to December 2018 and will require the temporary closure of areas and access during the works.
