Notice of Arrangements for Adoption of Supplementary Planning Documents (Regulation 19 of the Town and County Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulation 2004 as amended)

The Elmbridge Design and Character Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) was adopted on the 18 April 2012. The SPD provides design guidance relating to all new development in the Borough. Its overall aim is to ensure that the design of future development is more locally responsive, sustainable and built to a high quality. It forms part of the Elmbridge Local Plan.
