## Financial support

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**Citizens Advice** can give you free advice on debt, benefits, housing, employment and more:

**CHEER** (Concern and Help for East Elmbridge Retired) – supports residents over the age of 65 with benefits advice and can provide home visits. Call 07732 310 907.

**Breathing Space** is a government debt respite scheme which can give you protection from creditor action for up to 60 days, including freezing interest and charges. Call 0800 138 1111 for more info.

**Foodbanks** can provide support to residents who are in a food crisis. Contact Citizens Advice or CHEER who can make a referral to your local foodbank.

There are also **Community Fridges** where residents can donate or collect surplus food:

If you are worried about becoming homeless, you can contact the Council's **Housing Options Team** for advice on 01372 474 590.

**Rentstart** is a homeless charity working in Elmbridge. They offer prevention advice to people who are vulnerably housed and house and support those who are homeless. They also provide practical help on how to find rental housing. **Walton Charity** provides grant funding to individuals and families in Elmbridge who needs financial assistance for essential furniture, transport and training, or activities for children and young people. Referrals must come through Citizens Advice or social services.

**Walsingham Care** provides support to Elmbridge Residents over 60 experiencing financial hardship, with grants to support the rising cost of living. Applications must be submitted through a professional referee such as a social worker, GP, Citizens Advice, health practitioner, member of the clergy or housing association officer.

## Reduce your fuel bills

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**Action Surrey** is an advice service whose trained advisors can assist you to find ways to save money on your fuel bills. They can also check if you are eligible for grants to help make your home more energy efficient, which will help reduce costs. Call them on 0800 783 2503

If you are of pensionable age, have a long-term medical condition or a disability, you can sign up for the **Priority Services Register**. In the event of a power cut, your energy provider will then support you with text alerts, home visits and help with medication and medical equipment.

## Mental health support

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**Mind Matters Surrey** provides talking therapies to anyone over 17 registered with a Surrey GP, who is experiencing depression, anxiety or stress. Group and one-to-one therapy is offered via telephone and online. Call 0300 330 5450 for more info.

The **NHS Crisis Helpline** is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and is staffed by trained advisors who can support you if you are in a mental health crisis. Call 0800 915 4644 or text 07717 989 024.

**Catalyst Community Connections** provide telephone support and online activities for people with mental health, drug and alcohol problems in West Elmbridge (Walton, Weybridge and Hershaw). Call 01483 590 150 or SMS 07909 631 623.

**Mary Frances Trust** provide a range of online and in-person support groups and activities to support residents with mental health difficulties. Call 01372 375 400 for more info.

**Samaritans** are here to listen to anyone who is experiencing mental health problems. Call 116 123.

## Independent living support

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If you need some support with everyday tasks, there are local services that can help:

**Surrey County Council's Adult Social Care Team** provide short and long term assistance to help people maintain their independence. This includes personal care as well as wider support to help people engage with their communities. Call 0300 200 1005 for more info.

**Care And Repair Elmbridge** provide home adaptations to help you live more independently. From grab rails and wheelchair ramps to level access showers. They can also assist you to apply for financial assistance to pay for any work. CARE also runs a handyman service to carry out minor repair jobs in and around the home. **Community Alarm** provide a 24-hour monitoring service to help you live safely at home, with a wearable alarm unit, or equipment such as smoke alarms or fall detectors, which allow the monitoring team to alert family or emergency services. **HomeSupport Elmbridge** provide domestic services to adults with a long-term illness or disability, from cleaning and shopping services to bathing and befriending services. They are funds available to support residents in severe financial need. Call the HSE Team on 01932 267 128.

## Warm hubs

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**Warm Hubs** are places you can go to keep warm and get free advice on local support services. Many hubs also offer hot food and drink, as well as programmes of activities.
