Elmbridge's Centres for the Community are here to support residents to live full and active lives with a range of health and social activities, as well as advice and information sessions and classes for those who want to learn new skills.

In this booklet you'll find all the regular activities held across our Centres, from art to Zumba! Whether you're looking get more active, start a new hobby or get some advice and support, there's something for everyone.

Activities at our Centres are open to anyone with a Centre membership, available to residents over 18. A £21 annual membership gives you access to everything that's on at our Centres. To sign up, simply pop into a Centre and speak to one of the team.

Many of our activities are free, but some require a small charge to cover the cost of the tutor or trainer.
